

SIEM REAP, CAMBODIA







Siem Reap, Cambodia is a country that is firmly putting its past behind to embrace the 21st century and emerging as a vibrant tourist travel destination. It offers an opportunity to step into ancient history, get off the beaten track into a lush rural countryside and to immerse in a charming culture. It is a country where crumbling colonial buildings and tuk-tuks (motorized rickshaws) are juxtaposed with 5 star boutique hotels and trendy restaurants and spas.

Cambodia is bordered by Thailand, Laos and Vietnam and in its turbulent past, was invaded by two of its neighbors several times. It shares the powerful Mekong River with Laos and Vietnam. The river enters the country from Laos in the North, and in its southbound journey almost divides Cambodia into halves.

The Mekong splits off into two at Phnom Penh, Cambodia's capital, before ending in Vietnam. One of its tributaries feeds Tonle Sap (Great Lake), the largest fresh water lake in Southeast Asia, which lies south of Siem Reap, the town closest to the Angkor temple complex.

Clothing: With a Tropical Climate, sunglasses, a cap, sunscreen and comfortable loose clothing is the best. Many of the temples we will visit are still places of worship and modest clothing will be required. A light scarf to wrap around bare shoulders is a good idea, and best to avoid short dresses and skirts and sports shorts.

Weather: The dry season in Cambodia runs from October to April, and the wet season from May until September, with the heaviest rainfall generally in August & September. Average temperatures range from 24°C in the cooler months of October, November & December to 35°C at the hottest time of the year from March until June.







CUISINE WAT DAMNAK









DETAILS

Opened in 2011 by chef Johannes Rivieres, Cuisine Wat Damnak represents the culmination of Rivieres's knowledge of Khmer cuisine, while still offering many creative surprises. Having earned his stripes and made his name at Hotel de la Paix, Rivieres pioneered the hotel's tasting menu.

At Cuisine Wat Damnak, he continues to tailor two tasting menus a week, bringing many exciting flavor combinations to his diners. Here, the focus is not on traditional Cambodian dishes, but on sourcing local seasonal produce, such as edible flowers, kuy fruit and fish found only in the Mekong River and Tonle Sap Lake. This makes for a unique dining experience showcasing the best in contemporary Khmer gastronomy.

Marum is a social enterprise that opened its gate in 2009 and is a training restaurant for vulnerable young adults from orphanages and safe shelters, as well as underprivileged young adults from very rural poor areas.

By teaching them quality work skills as well as important life skills, we support these young people in their transition from institution to real world as well as giving them a chance to step out of the poverty cycle.

Marum is named after the Moringa, or 'Tree of life' - very appropriate, as customers will be enjoying a fantastic dining experience that helps build a new life for the students in training there!

It is named after the mythical white elephant that was supposedly ridden by Indra, the Hindu King of Gods.











ANGKOR - THE GRAND TOUR







DETAILS

Situated between the Tonle Sap lake and the Kulen Mountains, Angkor contains the magnificent remains of several capitals of the Khmer Empire and served as the seat of the Empire, which flourished from approximately the 9th to 15th centuries.


At its zenith the city boasted a population of on million people, the largest preindustrial city in the world.

The Angkor Temple Complex is the largest religious monument in the world at over 400 sc km.and more than a thousand temples.

Still today it is the spiritual heart of Cambodia, and can be found on its flag and currency.

We will not actually go inside the temple, we only stay in the grounds by the water reservoirs.



Water blessings are a traditional Cambodian practice that date back to ancient times, Despite being performed by Buddhist monks, the ceremony is not faith related. In Cambodia where Buddhism is practiced by around 90% of the population, it is a common sight to see monks in orange cloth chanting prayers and offering showers of blessings in temples.

You too can be part of this ritual where you receive blessings of luck and longevity from monks in a temple.

In this ritual, the monks chant blessings of good luck and safety ,followed by light sprinkles of water



ANGKOR CAFE



DETAILS

Enjoy a set lunch at the nice and fresh **Angkor Café** opposite the main entrance to Angkor Wat Temple.

This is the best restaurant inside the Angkor complex, and also features a nice handicraft shop selling high quality crafts and souvenirs. We will be served a set lunch with dessert.



TA PROHM





DETAILS

Unlike most of the temples of Angkor, Ta Prohm has been largely left to the clutches of the jungle. The interaction between nature and man-made art, this atmospheric temple is a favorite for many. Construction on Ta Prohm began in 1186 AD.

A rare inscription at Ta Prohm provides statistics on the temple's workers. Allowing for some exaggeration, the inscription's report of around 80,000 workers, including 2700 officials and 615 dancers, is still astounding.

Ta Prohm's popularity has soared in recent years along with the rest of the Angkor complex, but especially because of its appearance in the movie Lara Croft: Tomb Raider.



ANGKOR WAT - THE TEMPLE WITH AN ART HISTORIAN







DETAILS

Constructed in the early 12th century (between 1113 and 1150), Angkor Wat is considered to be the largest religious monument in the world. To put things in perspective Angkor Wat is four times the size of he Vatican City. Plus, the entire city of Angkor used more stone than all the Egyptian pyramids combined, and spread over an area larger than modern-day Paris.

We will be guided around Angkor Wat with the help of a Historian Expert Guide - to get a deeper understanding of the Art, archaeology and mythology behind one of the worlds most famous monuments.



ANGKOR NATIONAL MUSEUM









DETAILS

A modern and beautiful museum, with interactive exhibits and some of the best-preserved originals of the temples.

These originals have been moved to the museum for display and safekeeping from Temple robbers. This is a good preparation for visiting the temples.

In November 2007, the Angkor National Museum opened its doors, offering a comprehensive collection of Cambodian artifacts showcasing the origins of Khmer art, culture, and architecture. With eight galleries in total, it covers in depth the history of Cambodia and the Khmer Empire as well as a fascinating collection of Buddhist artifacts.

ANGKOR STONE CARVING ACTIVITY




DETAILS

Enjoy a 20 minute stone carving activity, where you get a hand's on interactive instruction in how to carve the stones of the Angkor Temple.

This is a great way to get a perspective on the amount of work needed to carve the temples and their sculptures and murals.



HOT AIR BALLOON OVER ANGKOR





DETAILS

An unforgettable balloon trip above the fascinating countryside of Siem Reap, rice fields, palm trees and (depending on the wind) over some temples. Within minutes of landing we are usually surrounded by a crowd of friendly and inquisitive village children: a perfect backdrop for your photographs.

There are two flights per day, for sunrise and sunset in Siem Reap for 25 - 30 persons per flight.

Average flight duration is 30 minutes or so, and is subject to the weather.

We visit the country side and villages of Siem Reap by, to explore the countryside and see and experience how the locals live.

Adventure ride to enjoy the countryside and villages where life, almost untouched by a fast changing Asia, goes on much as it has for centuries. Pass by monks, local villagers and school children.



ETHICAL SHOPPING - SENTEURS D'ANGKOR



DETAILS

Visit the organic and locally produced "Senteurs d'Angkor".

All made by hand, using traditional techniques and extracts derived from plant oils and **100 % natural ingredients** to create delicately perfumed oils, body creams, scrubs and bath salts. Tease your taste buds with fine spices including authentic Khmer curry, lemongrass, cinnamon, chili and famous Kampot pepper.

Senteurs d'Angkor prides itself on sourcing all of its products in Cambodia, from raw ingredients to packaging materials. In line with the philosophy of 'home-sourcing', most of the packaging comes from the sugar palm tree, an abundant, natural and recyclable resource in Cambodia.

This philosophy ensures that jobs and incomes stay within Cambodia, helping to address the country's poverty and reduce dependence on imports. Senteurs d'Angkor employ 110 people and provide regular work to another 100 people, mostly women from the rural area, 10% of the workshop staff are handicapped, and all benefit from good work conditions.



ETHICAL SHOPPING - CHANTIER ECOLE - ARTISANS D'ANGKOR









DETAILS

Visit the **Chantier Ecole - Artisan D'Angkor** to see the Art school where they teach a revival of the ancient and traditional Khmer crafts to new generations of young Artists.

Artisans d'Angkor originated as an educational project, developing into today's thriving social business.

Walk from one workshop to another to admire the knowledge and techniques in stone and wood carving, lacquering, silver plating and silk painting.

There is also an excellent shop selling the products of the Artisans, filled with well designed silks, accessories and pieces of Art.



NIGHT MARKET SHOPPING

After Dinner: visit the local Night
Market to shop for beautiful
handicrafts and souvenirs after dinner.

Angkor Night Market is Siem Reap's most renowned shopping venue, housing over 200 bamboo huts selling a wide range of clothing and handicrafts by local communities and non-governmental organizations.

Located in downtown Siem Reap, this outdoor market was established in 2007 in an effort to help preserve traditional Khmer handicrafts and improve the lives of Khmer people

Visit one of the rare remaining "Golden Silk" producers in the world.


Since the 13th century, the era of the Angkor kingdom, Khmer silk was considered to be the most beautiful in all South East Asia.
