Singapore, an island city-state off southern Malaysia, is a global financial center with a tropical climate and multicultural population. Its colonial core centers on the Padang, a cricket field since the 1830s and now flanked by grand buildings such as City Hall, with its 18 Corinthian columns.

Located at the tip of the Malay Peninsula, Singapore's tropical climate welcomes both leisure and business travelers year round. The island republic's excellent infrastructure enables visitors to enjoy its many sites and attractions in a safe, clean and green environment. Award winning Changi Airport provides airlinks to major cities around the world. The train and subway systems are clean, fast and efficient. Forming the core of downtown Singapore is the Colonial District. Each surrounding enclave has its own distinct flavor, from the aromatic spice stores of Little India, to the tumbledown backstreets of Chinatown, where it is still possible to find calligraphers and fortune tellers, or the Arab Quarter, whose cluttered stores sell fine cloths and silks.

Climate: Singapore is not insulated from the impact of climate change. From 1972 to 2014, the annual mean temperature has increased from 26.6°C to 27.7°C. The mean sea level in the Straits of Singapore has also increased at the rate of 1.2mm to 1.7mm per year in the period 1975 to 2009.




Changi Airport

Singapore Changi Airport, or simply Changi Airport, is the primary civilian airport for Singapore, and one of the largest transportation hubs in Southeast Asia. It is currently the World's Best Airport (Skytrax 2017), for the fifth consecutive year and counting (Skytrax's World's Best Airport 2013-2017) and is one of the world's busiest airports by international passenger traffic and cargo traffic. The airport is located in Changi, at the eastern end of Singapore, approximately 17.2 kilometres northeast from Marina Bay (in Singapore's Downtown Core), on a 13-square-kilometre site.





The 30 sqm Classic rooms in the new wing offer views of the Forest or the sea.








SHANGRI-LA RASA SENTOSA



DAY 1: BRANDED DECOR & SINGAPORE SLING OR PROSECCO






Our Bumboat can be privatised and branded with flags and assistants in branded clothes, to serve a pre-dinner Singapore Sling or Prosecco.


As we disembark the Bumboats - we can have a Group photo in front of the Merlion.

DAY 1: SINGAPORE - DINNER AT PALM BEACH SEAFOOD


DAY 2: SINGAPORE - MORNING ACTIVITY - 1HR TAI CHI IN UNESCO HERITAGE BOTANIC GARDENS

DAY 2: SINGAPORE - MORNING OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES




UNESCO Heritage Singapore Orchid Gardens:

DAY 2: SINGAPORE - LUNCH AT NATIONAL KITCHEN BY VIOLET OON









Celebrate Singapore's fine flavours at the **National Kitchen by Violet Oon** Singapore in the iconic historical City Hall building now home to the National Gallery.

Born a Singapore Nyonya in 1949, Violet Oon is the grande dame of Singaporean cooking and is widely considered to be an authority on Asian cuisine, specialising in Nyonya food. Her reputation as a chef and food connoisseur spans the international arena and she often represents Singapore as a food ambassador abroad.



DAY 2: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON OPTION 1: TIGER BEER





Step into the home of Tiger Beer and see how Singapore's iconic beer is brewed with just four high-quality ingredients during an interactive tour that includes unlimited beer tastings. You'll smell hops and other ingredients in the brew house before visiting the packaging gallery to observe the bottling process. Then head to the Tiger Tavern for a tasting session with different beer varieties.



DAY 2: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON OPTION 2: GARDENS BY THE BAY



Located next to Marina Reservoir, **Gardens by the Bay** offers breath-taking waterfront views. This multi-award winning horticultural destination spans 101 hectares of reclaimed land, which features the world's largest glass greenhouse, the Flower Dome – an impressive 1.28 hectares of flowers under glass.

DAY 3: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON OPTION: HERITAGE TOUR





Explore the living quarters, shops and even nightlife, providing a fascinating insight into some of the people who helped build this modern city.



DAY 3: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON OPTION: HERITAGE TOUR



Visit **Buddhas Tooth Relic Temple** in Chinatown. The temple is in the Tang Dynasty style housing a sacred item, the Sacred Buddha Tooth, which held in a magnificent Relic Stupa composed of gold donated by devotees.

DAY 3: SINGAPORE - LUNCH AT YUM CHA DIM SUM IN CHINATOWN

SINGAPORE: SINGAPORE FLYER MORNING OR EVENING




Located next to, Gardens by the Bay, this giant observation wheel offers 360-degree city views. On board the Singapore Flyer guests can see up to 45 kilometres away. During the ride up, passengers will get to see Singapore's East Coast, Marina Barrage, Gardens by the Bay, as well as the neighbouring islands of Malaysia and Indonesia.

It takes you 165 metres above ground and is Asia's largest giant observation wheel.

Step into one of the 28 fully airconditioned glass capsules, and be transported on a 30-minute journey of stunning day and night scenes.



DAY 4: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON - GROUP 1: SHOPPING ON ORCHARD ROAD






Orchard Road, is the central shopping Avenue in Singapore, with a mix of upscale malls like ION Orchard and PARAGON, as well as low to medium range malls such as Lucky Plaza and Ngee Ann Cty. Anything from fashion to souvenirs to electronics can be found here.



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DAY 4: SINGAPORE - AFTERNOON - GROUP 2: ACM MUSEUM OR NATIONAL MUSEUM



Housed in a historical building by the Singapore River, this museum tells the stories of Asian civilisations and is the only museum in the region devoted to exploring the artistic heritage of Asia. The ACM shines the spotlight on the historical connections between the cultures of Asia, and between Asia and the world.



If you have time to visit only one place to learn about the history and culture of Singapore, the National Museum of Singapore is probably it. With its history dating back to 1887, the National Museum is the nation's oldest, and one of the city's architectural icons. The museum focuses on exhibits related to the history of Singapore from the early 14th Century, then known as Temasek.



DAY 4: SINGAPORE - SENTOSA ISLAND - FOR FUN











Sentosa is an island resort off Singapore's southern coast, connected to the city by road, cable car, pedestrian boardwalk and monorail, with several hotels and restaurants.

Tiger Sky Tower has panoramic views that can stretch as far as Indonesia. Palawan Beach is lined with food stalls and bars, and has a suspension bridge to a small offshore island which is the Southernmost Point of Continental Asia. Activities include Ziplines, Surfmachines, a Luge and Combat Skirmish among the old Colonial Fort Siloso ruins.



DAY 4: SINGAPORE - SENTOSA ISLAND - BEACHES







Lauded by Condé Nast Traveller as one of the World's Best Beach Clubs, Tanjong Beach Club is a serene sanctuary located on the finest sun-soaked stretch of sand in Sentosa. On weekdays, it is a peaceful hideaway from Singapore's concrete jungle, offering a slice of tropical paradise mere minutes away from the heart of the city. Resorts World Sentosa is Singapore's integrated resort, offering key attractions including theme parks, hotels, spa, casino, and meeting & incentive venues.


At Universal Studios Singapore, go beyond the screen and Ride The Movies™, experience cutting-edge rides, shows, and attractions.


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DAY 4: SINGAPORE - LUNCH OPTION 2: AT FREMANTLE





SINGAPORE - DINNER OPTION 1: DINNER AT TAMARIND HILL




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SINGAPORE - DINNER OPTION 3: SALT GRILL & SKY BAR, 55th Floor

SINGAPORE - NIGHT SAFARI: EVENING OPTION AFTER DINNER









Nearly 20 years after it has opened its doors to the public, no other zoo in the world has been able to replicate the fabulous experience that is the Night Safari.

Here you will see hyenas, tigers, leopards, civets, badgers and other nocturnal animals freely roam around an environment that closely mimics that of their natural habitat.

The Singapore Night Safari is home to over 130 species totalling about 2500 nocturnal animals that graze, hunt and breed across the massive 40-hectare park.

We have the option of Priority tickets on the regular trams, or to rent private trams, with commentary by our guides in Spanish.





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
