

# DA NANG, VIETNAM







**Da Nang**, Vietnam's third largest city, and is located on the Eastern Sea coast, midway between Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City and the largest city of CentralVietnam. The city itself has neither the atmosphere of Hanoi nor the hustle-bustle of Ho Chi Minh City, but has its share of sights and is close to the ancient cities of charming Hoi An and the imperial capital of Hue, making it a popular vacationing spot for those looking to explore the attractions of central Vietnam or soak up some rays while hanging out on the city's beaches.

Vietnam is located on the eastern Indochina Peninsula and it covers a total area of approximately 331,210 km making it almost the size of Germany. At its narrowest point in the central Quảng Bình Province, the country is as little as 50 kilometres across, though it widens to around 600 kilometres in the north. Vietnam's land is mostly hilly and densely forested, with level land covering no more than 20%. Mountains account for 40% of the country's land area, and tropical forests cover around 42%.

**Clothing:** With a Tropical Climate, sunglasses, a cap, sunscreen and comfortable loose clothing is the best. Many of the temples we will visit are still places of worship and modest clothing will be required. A light scarf to wrap around bare shoulders is a good idea, and best to avoid short dresses and skirts and sports shorts.

**Weather:** Located in both a tropical and a temperate zone. It is characterized by strong monsoon influences, but has a considerable amount of sun, a high rate of rainfall, and high humidity. Regions located near the tropics and in the mountainous regions are endowed with a temperate climate.

#### HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN WALKING TOUR









#### **DETAILS**

The maritime importance of Hoi An dates back to as early as the 2 century BC. The town rose to prominence in the 16 century, and for the next two hundred years proved one of Vietnam's most important trading ports.

It has seen occupation by the Chinese, Japanese and Europeans, and their influence is visible throughout the old town, especially in the temples and houses built by merchants who came to trade but instead set down roots.

Towards the end of the 18-century the river slowly silted up; although this eventually led to the end of trade, it helped preserved the town, so that in 1999 it became a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



### CYCLO RIDE








#### **DETAILS**

After the Hoi An Ancient Town
Walking Tour, you can opt to have a
Vietnamese Cyclo Ride to the
Lunch/ Dinner Venue. The cyclo is a
three-wheel bicycle taxi that
appeared in Vietnam during the
French colonial period after a failed
attempt to introduce rickshaws. It is
the best way to get back in time
and appreciate the beauty of the
old town.



### DAY TRIP TO HUE - ANCIENT CAPITAL










#### **DETAILS**

Hue is the ancient capital of Imperial Vietnam, where the Nguyen Lords based their government during their reign over Vietnam between the 17th and 19th century. It remained the national capital until 1945, when Bao Dai (the collaborator king) escaped into exile and Ho Chi Minh declared independence from France in Hanoi.

As a result the city of Hue and its surroundings are covered with impressive monuments, temples and palaces. Despite suffering from its central position during the Vietnamese/ American War it truely deserves its status as a UNESCO World Heritage site, as everywhere you go there are impressive buildings jumping out of the countryside - to say nothing of the imperial palace of Hue itself.



### MARBLE MOUNTAIN CAVE, TEMPLE, ABSEILING










#### **DETAILS**

Named after the elements metal, wood, water, fire and earth, Marble Mountains exist in a coastal area that is renowned for stone-cutting and sculpture about 9km south of Danang. The caves within the mountains hold many secrets including bullet holes from when troops used to spy on the US soldiers relaxing on My Khe Beach below and buildings standing within the caves and grottoes.

There are also a host of Buddhist sanctuaries and places of worship dotted across the mountains which are a much-visited spiritual site. There are many pagoda temples and even a special circular cave featuring a chimney leading to the summit with spectacular panoramic views.



### **BOAT RIDE TO CHAM ISLAND**









#### **DETAILS**


After pickup from your hotel in Hoi An or Da Nang and head to port. Take in the fresh cool wind as you enjoy the beautiful landscape while riding on our speed boat to Cham Island. After arriving at Lang Beach, visit the marine protected area, boat shelter, Hai Tang Pagoda, and a traditional fishing village.

A breathtaking cluster of granite islands, set in aquamarine seas, around 15km directly offshore from Hoi An, the Cham Islands make a wonderful excursion. A rich underwater environment features 135 species of soft and hard coral and varied macrolife. The islands are officially protected as a marine park. Fishing and the collection of birds' nests (for soup) are the two key industries here.

### **GOLFING**





The Dunes course is situated on the fledgling central coast of Vietnam amid 150 hectares of dunescape similar to what the world's first golf courses were carved from. It lies in close proximity to two of Vietnam's most historic destinations — UNESCO World Heritage sites Hoi An and Hue — and offers breathtaking views of the Marble Mountains, East Sea and Cham Islands.









#### **MY SON SANCTUARY**









#### **DETAILS**

Between the 4th and 13th centuries a unique culture which owed its spiritual origins to Indian Hinduism developed on the coast of contemporary Viet Nam.

It is situated within an elevated geological basin surrounded by a ring of mountains, which provides the watershed for the sacred Thu Bon river. The source of the Thu Bon river is here and it flows past the monuments, out of the basin, and through the historic heartland of the Champa Kingdom, draining into the South China Sea at its mouth near the ancient port city of Hoi An. The location gives the sites its strategic significance as it is also easily defensible. T

he tower temples have a variety of architectural designs symbolizing the greatness and purity of Mount Meru, the mythical sacred mountain home of Hindu gods at the center of the universe. They are constructed in fired brick with stone pillars and decorated with sandstone bas-reliefs depicting scenes from Hindu mythology. Their technological sophistication is evidence of Cham engineering skills while the elaborate iconography and symbolism of the tower-temples give insight into the content and evolution of Cham religious and political thought.








#### DA NANG NATIONAL MUSEUM









#### **DETAILS**

The Museum of Danang is located inside Dien Hai Rampart, the national historical monument marking the first fighting of Da Nang soldiers and people against the French – Spanish Coalition Forces (1858-1860). The construction for the museum began in April 2005 and completed in April 2011.

With a display area of 3000m2, the museum introduces more than 2,500 items of valuable objects and documents on the subjects of Natural and social history of Da Nang; History of the revolutionary struggle; War remnants of U.S Army in Da Nang and the surroundings; Cultural characteristics of ethnic groups in Da Nang and Quang Nam.



#### CAM THANH WETLAND SAFARI IN BASKET BOAT









#### **DETAILS**

Cam Thanh Commune of Hoi An City, Quang Nam Province situates in a lower Thu Bon River mouth, about 3km south-east of Hoi An City and 28 km southward from Da Nang City. The most well grown and common plants seen in Cam Thanh are Nypa palms (Nypa fruticans), which creates an unique and scenic mangrove ecosystem for Hoi An Heritage City.

For people in Cam Thanh commune, Nypa wetland provide many values such as fish, shells. Nypa leaves and other products, and asthetic landscape for tourism. Nypa palm forest also provided very important function to local people as it serve as ideal refuge for boats during heavy storms and typhoons.

## PRE-COCKTAIL



#### **FUJIAN HALL**









#### **DETAILS**

Fujian (Phuc Kien) Assembly Hall was built around 1690 and functions as a traditional assembly hall for the Chinese ethnic group from Fujian, China to socialise, but later was transformed into a temple dedicated to their deity named Thien Hau – the goddess of sea who protects sailors from danger.

Throughout the temple, there are a plethora of statues, bronze drums, bronze bells and horizontal lacquered board engraved with Chinese characters. The whole combination and arrangement of every element in the hall tend to imply the Chinese philosophy of happiness.




