




Sunset Cable Car Ride & Sightseeing tour

Surrounded by ramparts and fortresses, it is a treasure of architectural and cultural masterpieces, well preserved over the centuries.






A pleasant walk with a professional licensed guide along "Stradun" and through the tiny streets will make you feel like have been set back in time. You will get to see some of the most attractive sights in the Old Town: Palace Sponza, Rector's Palace, a still operating fountains with fresh water from one of the first water supply system (first half of the 15.ct.) and much more.

We end our walk with a dinner at the Restaurant Dubrovnik, a small corner of gastronomy, place where you can relax and enjoy specialties of the Dubrovnik region. Fish specialties, as well as popular meat dishes and carefully selected ingredients prepared by the best Dubrovnik chefs are served on the summer terrace.

#### Konavle & The Tale of Silk

Discover hidden treasures in Dubrovnik: Silk Production in Konavle. According to the oldest written records, silk production in Dubrovnik's Konavle region goes back to the 15th century. Silk was an exceptionally important fabric here since it was used in weaving the Konavle folk dress one of the most beautiful aspects of Croatian cultural heritage. In this part of the world, people literally were born with silk, lived with it and died with it, and the art of producing silk was passed among women from generation to generation.



Women from Konavle had great respect for the tradition of breeding silkworms and making silk; it was a part of their regional identity and a family tradition to which they remained loyal.

We will take you for a visit of the family house Slovak where you will be welcomed with a typical homemade drink and sweets. Afterwards you will have the opportunity to experience and become familiar with the whole process of silk producing in the most traditional manner. Before return, a typical Dalmatian snack will be served together with local wine from Konavle.

Horse back riding in the Konavle region

The horseback riding tour enables you to truly become one with nature; there are only the rider and the horse- a rest for the soul and the body.

The riding tour (two hours / 11 Km) starts at the Koral in Konavle region and takes the guests through unexplored forest paths, along the Konavle rocks coastline, entering the preserved archaeological residues of the village Popovici while experiencing the beauty of the region.



The guide provides the guests with their safety gear and introduces them to their horses, and presents the fundamentals of horseback riding. Upon our return to the Koral a small snack is offered to our guests (prosciutto ham and cheese sandwiches, local wine, refreshing drinks).



#### ATW Quad Safari in Konavle

The ATW Quad Safari is planned out as the best possible experience of the region of Konavle and Dubrovnik countryside, safe but at the same time exciting.

After the introduction and briefing the safari continues through beautiful olive groves, pine forests, along the amazing Konavle rocky coast to the picturesque village of Cilipi, continues through the fields and cross the river Ljuta.

southern slopes of the peninsula. They are all about sun, sea, stone and really wine story at one of the local vineries.


